

CONFRONTING AGGRESSORS AT THE DOOR

JUSTICE MICHAEL KIRBY 1998 AUSTRALIAN HIGH COURT RULING – *NO-ONE BUT NO – ONE, NOT EVEN THE QUEEN COULD TRESPASS OR TAKE PROPERTY HELD IN FEE SIMPLE – EQUATES TO THEFT.*

Actual wording was:

Point 47: 'Subject to whatever qualifications may be imposed by statute or the common law, or by reservation or grant, the holder of an estate in fee simple may use the land as he or she sees fit and may exclude any and everyone from access to the land.' & Point 93: 'It confers, and since the beginning of legal history it always has conferred, the lawful right to exercise over, upon, and in respect to, the land, every act of ownership which can enter into the imagination'.
